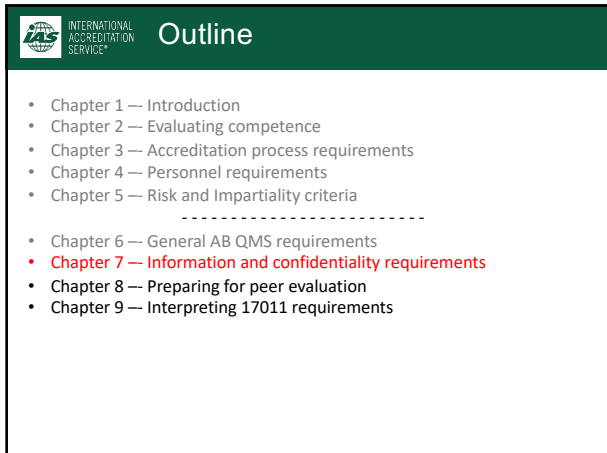
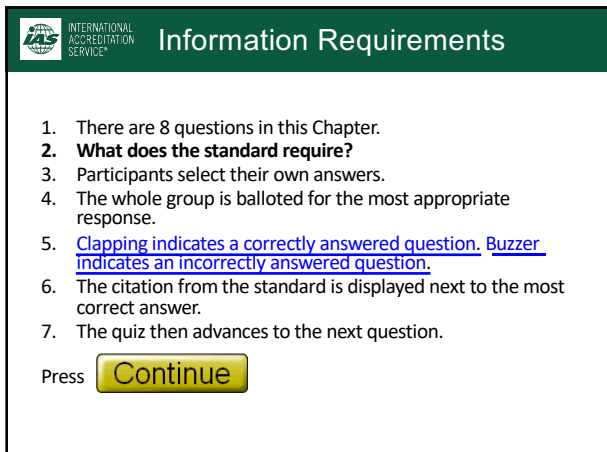

Information Requirements

8.1 Confidential Information

ISO/IEC 17011 requires ABs to completely treat as confidential **ALL** information obtained about a CAB during the accreditation process.

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Information Requirements

8.1 Confidential Information

ISO/IEC 17011 requires ABs to divulge any information regarding a CAB to any official lawyer requesting it, and need not inform the CAB of such release.

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Information Requirements

8.1 Confidential Information

The AB shall not release the name of any person or organisation providing information about the conformity assessment body obtained from sources other than the conformity assessment body itself.

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Information Requirements

Clause 8.2 contains all of the requirements that used to be contained in Clause 7.1 of 17011:2004. However, it now groups this information into:

- Information about the AB, and
- Information about accreditation

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Information Requirements

The concept of “Publicly Available Information” has traditionally included:

- Published information (website or book), and
- Information available on request.

17011:2004 did not specify which was appropriate for which circumstance – published scopes versus lists of suspended cabs

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Information Requirements

Clause 8.2.2 requires an AB to make “publicly available without request” all information related to a CAB scope of accreditation and information related to suspension or withdrawal of accreditation.

NOTE This may cause difficulties for some ABs whose actions to follow such a requirement may place them in breach of fiduciary responsibility of their agreement with a CAB. This may affect only those ABs in North America.
