

Assessor evaluation - Case Study 07

Name: - *Publicity Requirements*

A laboratory was found to have listed all its laboratories in a national telephone directory. There was one listing and it carried the corporate name of the company and all the lab locations of the same name, each one in a different city.

Of the six laboratories named, only four were accredited to ISO/IEC 17025 by an ILAC-recognized accreditation body. Two were not.

Within the actual listing were the words: “Accredited to ISO/IEC 17025 by _____ (accreditation body) for the tests listed on associated scopes of testing.” There was no further information on the listing to distinguish between those labs accredited and those not accredited.
